

MACE Program FAQ's

What is the MACE degree program at DBU?

The Master of Arts in Christian Education is a 42 hour, non-thesis program consisting of 30 hours of core courses and 12 hours of electives or concentration hours. This degree program is designed for those interested in answering God's call to serve Him through Christian education. Through your studies at DBU, you will be equipped to fulfill the servant leader role in Christian education to which God has called you.

How can I apply for the MACE degree program?

Individuals seeking admission into any graduate degree program at DBU must submit an application for admission to the Graduate Admissions Office.

May I transfer credits from another institution?

Yes. A maximum of 12 graduate level credits earned at accredited institutions may be considered for transfer credit toward the MACE degree at DBU. You will need to submit prior transcripts to the program director for review and evaluation.
